“The Beginning of Faith”

1 Now faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen. 2 For by it the people of old received their commendation. ... 6 And without faith it is impossible to please him, for whoever would draw near to God must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who seek him.

I. Faith is placing all your confidence in what you cannot see. (vv. 1-2)

II. Faith is believing God exists. (v. 6a)

6 And without faith it is impossible to please him, for whoever would draw near to God must believe that he exists – **Hebrews 11:6a ESV**

19 For what can be known about God is plain to them, because God has shown it to them. 20 For his invisible attributes, namely, his eternal power and divine nature, have been clearly perceived, ever since the creation of the world, in the things that have been made. So they are without excuse. - **Romans 1:19-20 ESV**

III. Faith is seeking to please God through your actions. (v. 6b)

6 ... that he rewards those who seek him. – **Hebrews 11:6b ESV**

6 He will render to each one according to his works: 7 to those who by patience in well-doing seek for glory and honor and immortality, he will give eternal life; 8 but for those who are self-seeking and do not obey the truth, but obey unrighteousness, there will be wrath and fury.

- **Romans 2:6-8 ESV**

17 So also faith by itself, if it does not have works, is dead. 18 But someone will say, "You have faith and I have works." Show me your faith apart from your works, and I will show you my faith by my works.

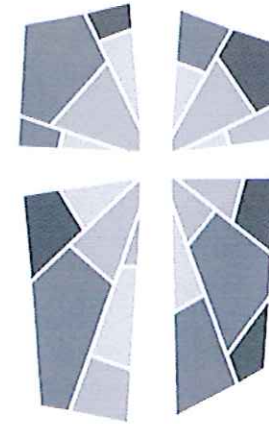
