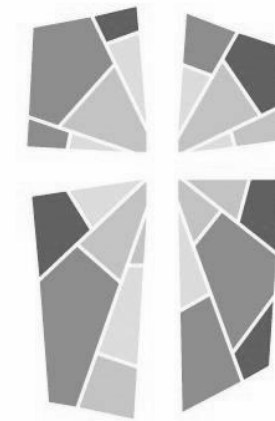

“Through Jesus, We Are Citizens of Heaven, Comforters, and Christ’s Ambassadors”

I. We are citizens of Heaven

20 But our citizenship is in heaven, and from it we await a Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ, - **Philippians 3:20 ESV**

27 Only let your manner of life be worthy of the gospel of Christ, so that whether I come and see you or am absent, I may hear of you that you are standing firm in one spirit, with one mind striving side by side for the faith of the gospel, - **Philippians 1:27 ESV**

6 do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. 7 And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.
- **Philippians 4:6-7 ESV**

18 If possible, so far as it depends on you, live peaceably with all.
- **Romans 12:18 ESV**

II. We are comforters of others

14 For he himself is our peace, who has made us both one and has broken down in his flesh the dividing wall of hostility
- **Ephesians 2:14 ESV**

3 Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of mercies and God of all comfort, 4 who comforts us in all our affliction, so that we may be able to comfort those who are in any affliction, with the comfort with which we ourselves are comforted by God. - **2 Corinthians 1:3-4 ESV**

III. We are Christ’s ambassadors to the world.

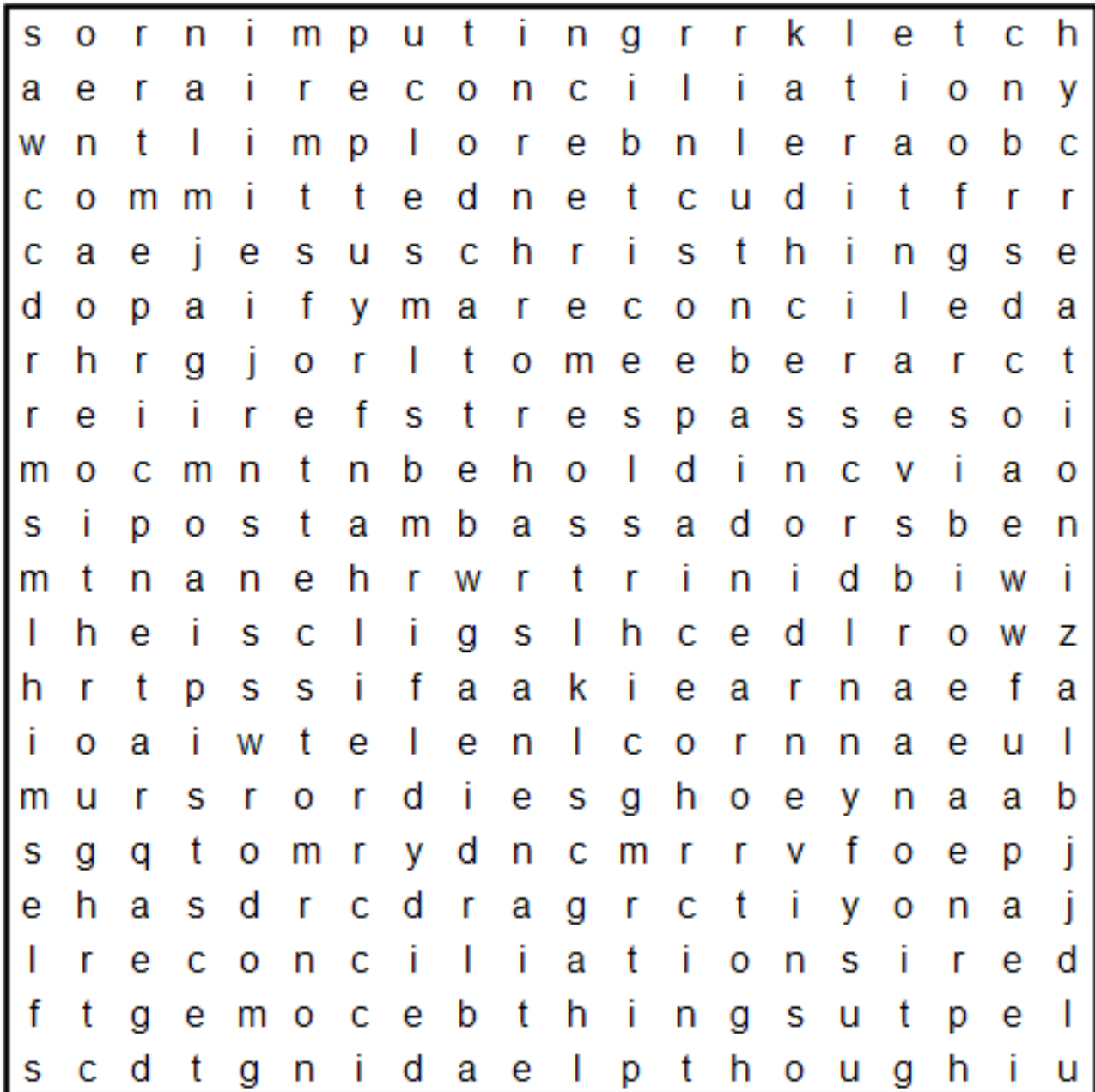
17 Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation. The old has passed away; behold, the new has come. 18 All this is from God, who through Christ reconciled us to himself and gave us the ministry of reconciliation; 19 that is, in Christ God was reconciling the world to himself, not counting their trespasses against them, and entrusting to us the message of reconciliation. 20 Therefore, we are ambassadors for Christ, God making his appeal through us. We implore you on behalf of Christ, be reconciled to God.

2 Corinthians 5:17-20 ¹⁷ **Therefore**, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new. ¹⁸ Now all things are of God, who has reconciled us to Himself through Jesus Christ, and has given us the ministry of reconciliation, ¹⁹ that is, that God was in Christ reconciling the world to Himself, not imputing their trespasses to them, and has committed to us the word of reconciliation.

²⁰Now then, we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God were pleading through us: we implore you on Christ's behalf, be reconciled to God. (NKJV)
