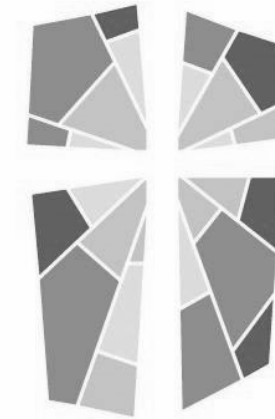

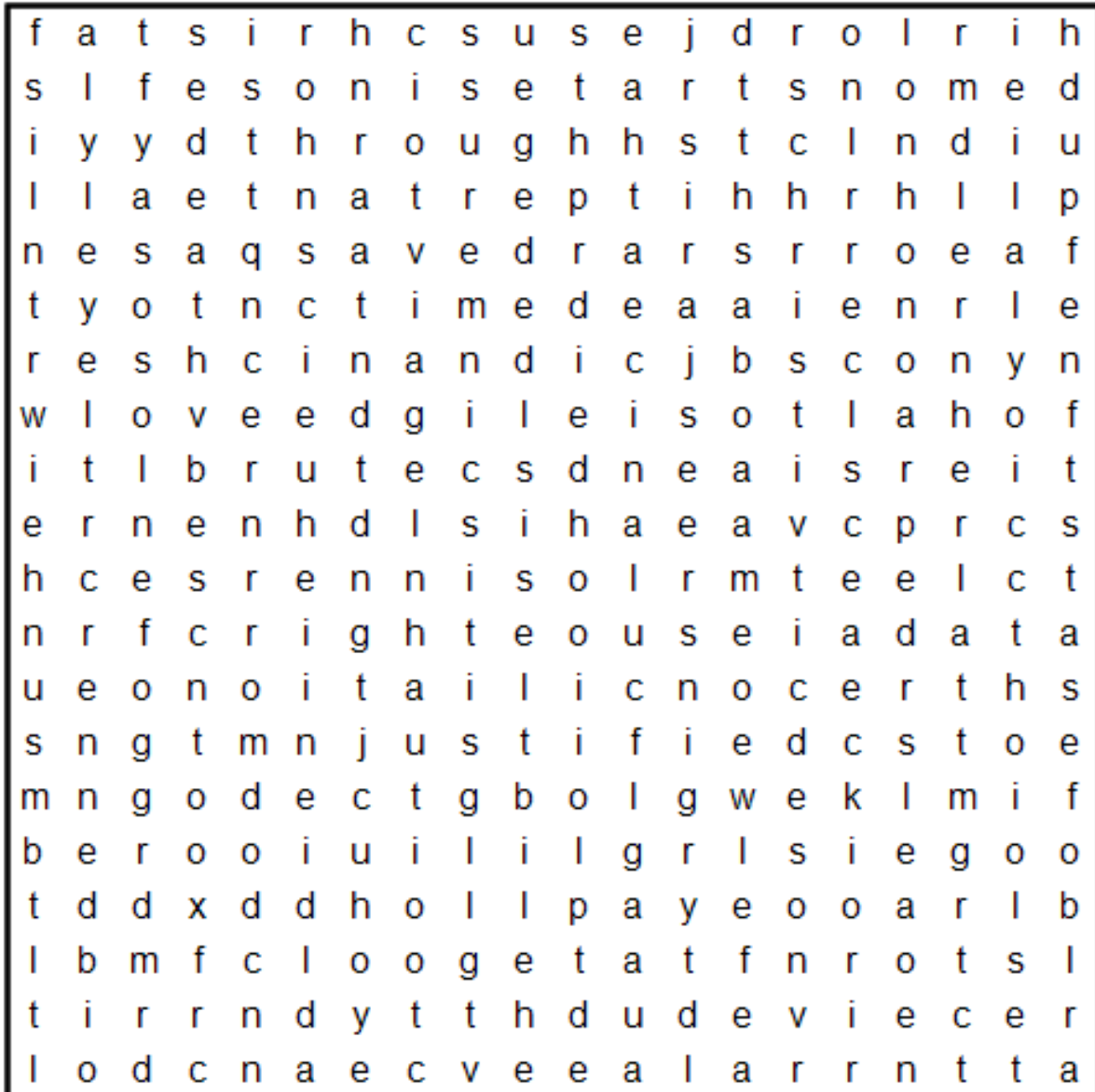
Prayer Requests from our neighbors:
