## “All Human Life is Precious”

### I. Humanity is unique among creation

27 So God created man in his own image, in the image of God he created him; male and female he created them. - **Genesis 1:27 ESV**

7 then the LORD God formed the man of dust from the ground and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life, and the man became a living creature. - **Genesis 2:7 ESV**

### II. Humanity is superior to the rest of the living creatures

5 And for your lifeblood I will require a reckoning: from every beast I will require it and from man. From his fellow man I will require a reckoning for the life of man. - **Genesis 9:5 ESV**

28 "When an ox gores a man or a woman to death, the ox shall be stoned, and its flesh shall not be eaten, but the owner of the ox shall not be liable. 29 But if the ox has been accustomed to gore in the past, and its owner has been warned but has not kept it in, and it kills a man or a woman, the ox shall be stoned, and its owner also shall be put to death. ... 35 "When one man's ox butts another's, so that it dies, then they shall sell the live ox and share its price, and the dead beast also they shall share. - **Exodus 21:28-29, 35 ESV**

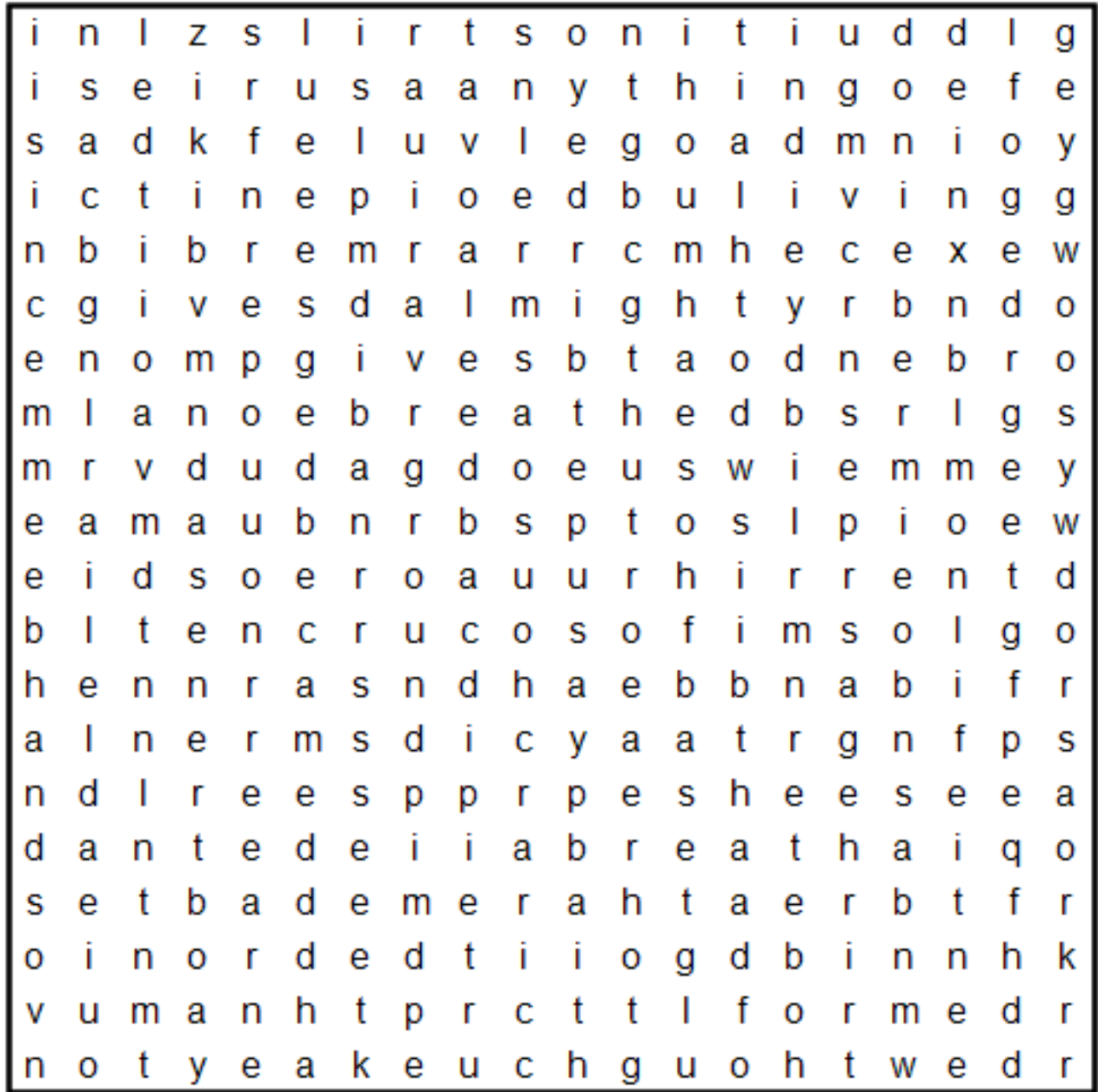
5 to redeem those who were under the law, so that we might receive adoption as sons. - **Galatians 4:5 ESV**

For the trumpet will sound, and the dead will be raised imperishable, and we shall be changed. 53 For this perishable body must put on the imperishable, and this mortal body must put on immortality. 54 When the perishable puts on the imperishable, and the mortal puts on immortality, then shall come to pass the saying that is written: "Death is swallowed up in victory." 55 "O death, where is your victory? O death, where is your sting?" 56 The sting of death is sin, and the power of sin is the law. 57 But thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ. - **1 Corinthians 15:50-57 ESV**

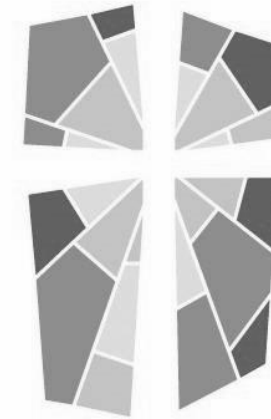
