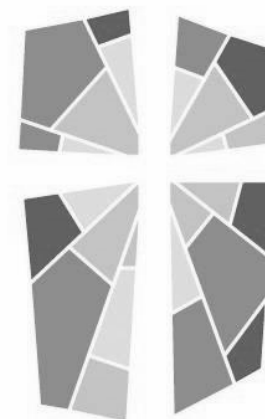

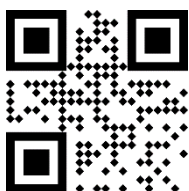



Psalm 139:7-12

“Knowing Your Father – God is Omnipresent”

I. God being omnipresent means that He is present everywhere.

God’s omnipresence is related to His omnipotence and omniscience.

God’s omnipresence also follows from the fact He is infinite.

“God is equally present with all his creature at all times and in all places” – Charles Hodge

Omnipresence is not the same as pantheism.

28 "for in Him we live and move and have our being, ..."

- Acts 17:28 NKJV

II. Scripture teaches us that God is omnipresent.

7 Where can I go from Your Spirit? Or where can I flee from Your presence? 8 If I ascend into heaven, You [are] there; If I make my bed in hell, behold, You [are there]. 9 [If] I take the wings of the morning, [And] dwell in the uttermost parts of the sea, 10 Even there Your hand shall lead me, And Your right hand shall hold me. 11 If I say, "Surely the darkness shall fall on me," Even the night shall be light about me; 12 Indeed, the darkness shall not hide from You, But the night shines as the day; The darkness and the light [are] both alike [to You].

- Psalm 139:7-12 NKJV

23 "[Am] I a God near at hand," says the LORD, "And not a God afar off?

24 Can anyone hide himself in secret places, So I shall not see him?"

says the LORD; "Do I not fill heaven and earth?" says the LORD.

1 Thus says the LORD: "Heaven [is] My throne, And earth [is] My footstool. Where [is] the house that you will build Me? And where [is] the place of My rest? - Isaiah 66:1 NKJV

III. God is omnipresent, but not present in the same sense with all His creatures.

“He is present with all by the presence of his divinity, but only with his saints by the presence of a gracious efficacy. He walks in the middle of the golden candlesticks and has dignified the congregation of his people with the title “Jehovah Shamma,” the Lord is there (Ezek 48:35) ... as he filled the tabernacle, so he doth the church, with the signs of his presence: this is not the presence wherewith he fills heaven and earth.”

We can be out of fellowship with God, even while we are in the presence of God.

16 Then Cain went out from the presence of the LORD and dwelt in the land of Nod on the east of Eden. - Genesis 4:16 NKJV

IV. Does it matter that God is omnipresent?

“the practice of the presence of God” consists not of projecting an imaginary object from within his own mind and then seeking to realize its presence; it is rather to recognize the real presence of the One who all sound theology declares to be already there, an objective entity, existing apart from any apprehension of Him on the part of His creatures.” – Tozer

Because God is omnipresent, we can meet with God anywhere.

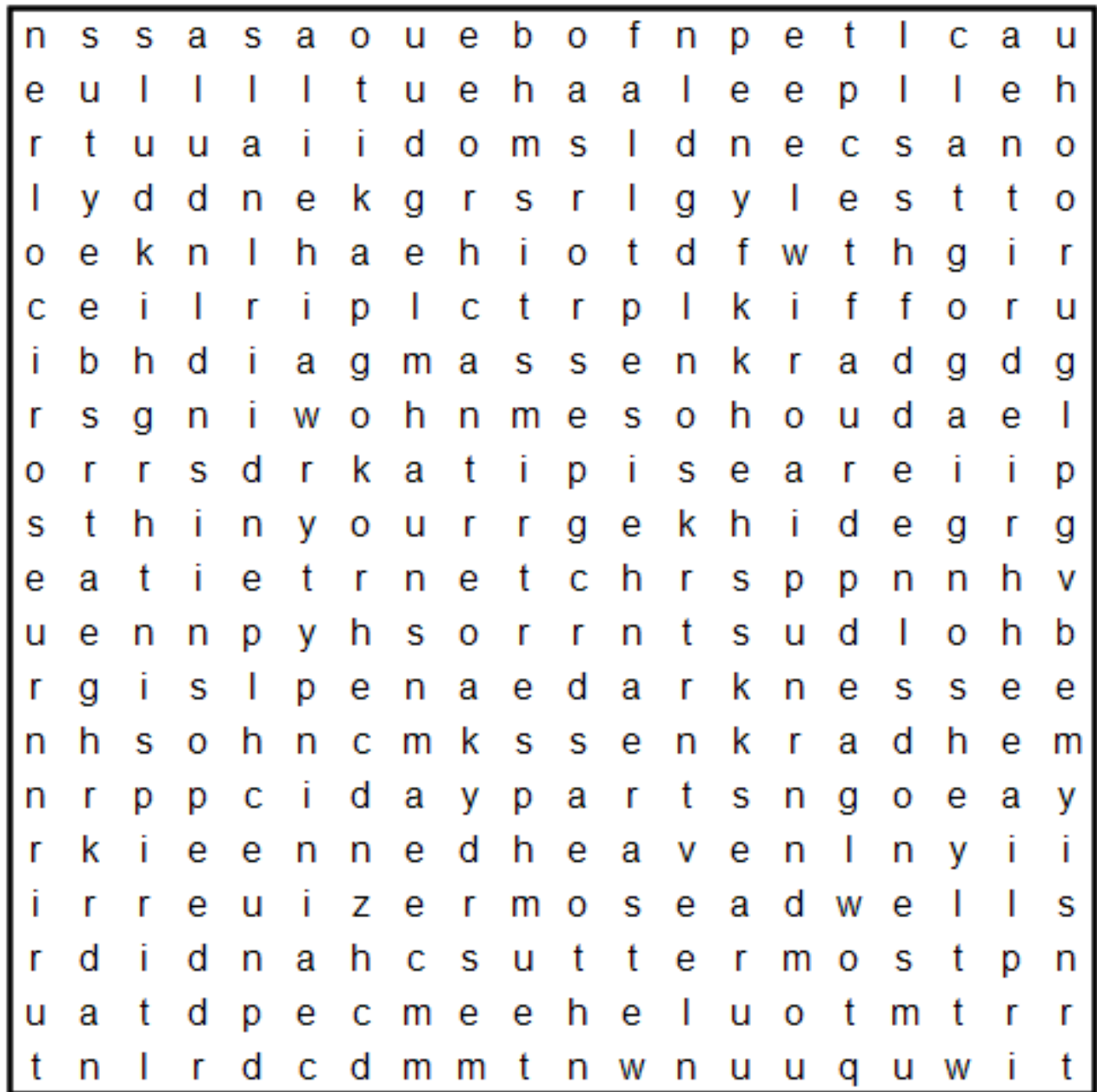
Because God is omnipresent, He is with us everywhere.
